The Pioneer Amateur Radio Club Meeting for July was called to order at 730 PM by President Darlene Hoffman, N0LOP. 25 people were present. Everyone introduced themselves.

MINUTES and TREASURER'S REPORT: The June minutes and July Treasurer's report were approved as printed in the PARC News.

MOTION to Pay Bills: Sharon Martens, KB0TVB reported that she paid Dave Theophilus, W0NRW \$28.75 for Field Day hamburger.

HOSPITALITY: KB0TVB had nothing to report.

EDUCATION: Jane Mehaffey, KB0ZUN had nothing to report.

FIELD DAY: Larry Martens, K0SW reported that except for the thunderstorms everything went ok. The same site has been booked for 2015. Wes Chrisman, KD0PGV reported that although there were no Boy Scouts this year everybody had lots of fun.

FLEA MARKET: Rich Mehaffey, KB0ARZ reported that 41 tables were leased and everybody seemed to be happy. He thought the equipment for sale was of a better quality than in previous years. 400 raffle tickets were sold. A motion to donate an additional \$25 to St. Charles Church for the additional space used was approved after a motion by Dok Doksansky, WA0RHY and a second by Mel Cunningham, K0VLA. A detailed financial report was given by KB0ZUN which showed a profit of \$168.78. We need suggestions on how to get people into the additional side rooms. The date for 2015 has been set for July 11. Bill Jackson, K9RZ reported on the VE testing with 3 of the 4 candidates successful in obtaining an upgrade or first time license. N0LOP will give a financial report for Darlene's Diner at a later date.

NET Manager: K0VLA passed around sign-up sheets for Net Control duties and thanked everybody.

ARES: W0NRW thanked everybody for the rain reports.

N0LOP asked for members to bring suggestions to the August meeting for drawing down the treasury by approximately \$2400. K9RZ explained the new exam credit that will be given in future VE testing. N0LOP said that Joe Eisenberg, K0NEB will present a program in August.

The meeting was adjourned at 825 PM.
