North Bend Students Learn About Amateur Radio

For one hour each day on May 13 and 14, Steve Benke, KFØMS and Dave Theophilus, WØNRW, gave a Pioneer Amateur Radio Club demonstration of amateur radio to eight 5th grade students at the North Bend Schools.

Rich Mehaffey, KBØARZ and Jane Mehaffey, KBØZUN, had set up an HF vertical antenna and WØNRW provided an HF transceiver.

But due to solar storming the HF bands were in terrible shape on both days. We could only hear a few signals on 20 meters and they were barely above the noise level.

So, we went to Plan B which involved using an iPhone with the Echo-Link App on the 146.67 KDØEFC repeater. It worked great and the students were able to speak with KDØEFC, NØLGU, KBØDYY and KØRJE.

The classroom was equipped with a SmartBoard connected to the Internet which we used to display several amateur radio videos as well as images of the sunspots on the sun to supplement our talk.

The Mehaffeys had also printed amateur radio handouts for the students.

Thanks to everybody who participated in the demonstration.

Pioneer Amateur Radio Club Minutes for April 23, 2015

MINUTES and TREASURER'S REPORT: The March Minutes and April Treasurer's Report were approved as printed in the April PARC News.

MOTION to Pay Bills: No bills.

EDUCATION: Jane Mehaffey, KBØZUN reported that the North Bend 5th graders requested an amateur radio demonstration on May 13-14 from 210 PM to 310 PM each day. Don Renze, KØOM moved that PARC donate \$100 to Izaak Walton for the use of their facility. The motion was seconded by KFØMS and was approved. FLEA MARKET: July 11, 2015 in North Bend. KBOARZ reported that he had purchased an IPad Mini for a prize. It was suggested that he also contact MFJ for prizes. ARRL has donated \$150 worth of prizes. Wes Chrisman, KDØPGV offered to give a demonstration of his new repeater if there was room and time available. There will also be a Test Session.

CHRISTMAS PARTY: December 12, 2015 at the Office Bar & Grill in Hooper. KBØZUN will check with Linda Kirchmann, WØZIP confirming the date.

NET Manager: Mel Cunningham, KØVLA passed around sign-up sheets for Net Control duties and thanked everybody.

ARES: WØNRW thanked the precipitation reporters for furnishing their latitude/longitude so that the National Weather Service can make better use of their reports.

OLD BUSINESS: The FCC is working on the interference caused by a Plattsmouth ham on area repeaters. WØNRW reported that the Friends of the Library Book Sale grossed \$12,723.

Life membership is \$200.


